

Taking Learning Assessments Online

You can use the Learning Assessment system (LA) to take learning assessments online and receive immediate feedback on your results.

Taking an Online Assessment

1. In your teacher's email, click the link to the online assessment, or go to la.ldschurch.org/online.
2. Sign in with your LDS Account username and password.
3. If needed, select the program or subject from the drop-down menu. Click **Start test** for the learning assessment that you need. You may need to enable pop-ups to view the learning assessment.
4. Review the instructions, and then click **Start**.
5. Select your answer, and then click **Next**. If needed, you can click **Previous** to return to a question. The assessment will automatically save, so you can leave the assessment if needed and return later to complete it.
6. For the essay questions, type your answer. When finished, click **Evaluate My Response**. (If your answer is too brief, the button will not activate.) Then scroll down to see the response guide. Compare your answer to see if it is in line with the guide. Then mark **Yes** or **No**, and click **Next**.
7. When you have finished all of the assessment questions, click **Submit**. Confirm your submission by clicking **Yes**.
8. Click **Continue** to begin the Belief and Apply Surveys. Select your answers, and then click **Next**. When you have finished the survey questions, click **Submit**. Confirm your submission by clicking **Yes**.


