MMD Fleet Used Vehicle Sales Purchase Program – Public Sales

Vehicle Review–Test Drive

A current *For Sale List* of available vehicles is maintained by Fleet Vehicle Sales. The list has two sections: (1) an *Ongoing List*, which consists of all unsold vehicles, except for those vehicles which are newly added each week, and (2) the *Newly Added List*, which is generated each Monday at 3:00 p.m. (except holidays).

(1) *Ongoing List*: If you are interested in seeing or test driving any of the vehicles listed, you may do so during normal business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.), except holidays, at Fleet Vehicle Sales located on the third lower level (3LL) of the parking plaza at the Church Office Building located at 50 East North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah. Test drives must return by 4:00 p.m. **There are no overnight test drives!**

(2) *Newly Added List*: Each Monday at 3:00 p.m., additional vehicles may be listed for the first time (dependent upon inventory). The first time these newly added vehicles may be purchased will be on the next day (Tuesday) at 7:00 a.m.—the Church Office Building opens at 7:00 a.m. Individuals desiring to purchase vehicles will draw numbers at 7:00 a.m. Number 1 will have first choice of vehicles; number 2 will have second choice, and so on. Therefore, there is no advantage to arriving earlier than 7:00 a.m. These vehicles may be first viewed after 3:00 p.m. on Monday, but no test drives on the newly added vehicles will be allowed until the vehicles go on sale the next morning. All newly added vehicles which are not sold on Tuesday morning will migrate to the *Ongoing List* and will then be available in accordance with that lists' guidelines.

Purchase Process

After numbers have been drawn, each person will be called into the office in numerical order. A **\$50.00** deposit (of cash or personal check) is required to hold a vehicle for 3 business days to allow you to obtain financing and insurance. To complete the purchase, a cashier's check or other form of certified funds, made payable to **Corp Pres Bishop Church of Jesus Christ LDS** for the exact sales price of the vehicle, is required. Personal checks, cash, debit cards, or credit cards will not be accepted. Upon receipt of your certified funds, your \$50.00 deposit will be returned to you.

Once you have purchased a vehicle, you will receive (1) a Bill of Sale, (2) the original title, (3) an Odometer Disclosure Statement, and (4) a current safety inspection certificate. Since different counties stipulate varying emissions test requirements, it is your responsibility to obtain one if needed.

The current license plates will be removed from your vehicle upon completion of the sale. This leaves you with two options:

Option 1: You may leave your vehicle with us while you go to the DMV to register it and then bring back the new license plates that we will put on for you. **OR**

Option 2: If you elect to drive the vehicle directly to the DMV to register it, you should keep in the vehicle with you the Odometer Disclosure Statement, and you run the risk of receiving a citation for driving an unregistered/unlicensed vehicle. If you receive a citation, you are solely responsible for paying it and for any other consequences associated with it.

Insurance Coverage

Once the sales transaction has taken place (exchange of certified funds for a Bill of Sale, Title, Odometer Disclosure Statement, and a current safety inspection certificate), you are immediately and solely responsible to provide insurance coverage for your vehicle. Usually a phone call to your insurance agent/company, prior to purchasing the vehicle, is sufficient for temporary insurance coverage. However, you are responsible to make sure you have current coverage of the vehicle at the time of purchase.
