## CODE OF HONOR

The Laramie LDS Institute of Religion of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints wishes to encourage students of the highest moral caliber to attend the University of Wyoming and help maintain an atmosphere supportive of the development of men and women who will champion the preservation of Christian ideals and principles. In accepting a scholarship, a person signifies a willingness to live by the following principles, whether on or off campus:

3. Abide by the standard of Christian living taught by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. This includes graciousness and consideration of others and observance of high principles of honor, integrity, and morality.
4. Be honest in their behavior. This includes not cheating, plagiarizing, or knowingly give false information.
5. Respect the rights of others:  
This includes (a) not physically or verbally abusing any person and not engaging in conduct that threatens or endangers the health or safety of others; and (b) not obstructing or disrupting the study of others; the performance of official duties by University personnel; the teaching, research, disciplinary, administrative, or other functions of the University, or other authorized activities on University premises.
6. Respect property rights. This includes refraining from theft, damage, or misuse of the property of others.
7. Obey, honor and sustain the law.
8. Avoid drug use. This includes refraining from possession, use, or distribution of any narcotic or dangerous drug (as defined by law), except as prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner.
9. Comply with University of Wyoming regulations. This includes compliance with rules relating to campus organizations and to the use of University or off-campus housing or other facilities.
10. Observe the Word of Wisdom. This includes abstinence from alcoholic beverages, tobacco, tea, coffee, and drugs.
11. Be morally clean. This includes abstinence from all illicit sexual relations.
12. Observe high standards of taste and decency. This includes refraining from disorderly, lewd, indecent, or obscene conduct and expression.
13. Observe decent standards of dress and grooming.
12. Attend a class at the Laramie LDS Institute of Religion each semester.
13. Help others fulfill their responsibilities under this code.
