

PARKING POLICY

This policy was adopted in November 1995 to address the concern for resident safety and to assure adequate parking for residents and their guests. This is how it works:

Resident's parking

1. Residents must register your vehicle with your head resident, receive a parking assignment and a current parking permit to be affixed to the front or rear window of registered vehicle. This permit identifies your vehicle as legally belonging and will protect it from being towed, so place it where it is visible to the outside.
2. Please park only in your space. In the event someone parks in your space without your permission, report it to your head resident. While you are waiting for your parking space to be vacated, you may temporarily park in a space reserved for visitors (south side driveway) or the Institute parking lot. These options are only available for special circumstances and should not be used routinely.
3. If you choose to park in someone's assigned parking space without permission, your vehicle is subject to being towed at your expense. Having a Student Center permit does not allow you to park in someone else's assigned parking space or the Institute parking lot.
4. Assigned spaces are issued only to residents of the Student Center. If a resident does not own a car, he/she cannot secure a space to be used by family or a friend.

Visitor's parking

1. All visitors must park in visitors' parking (south side driveway) and sign the vehicle log located next to each head resident's apartment (Apt #21 of the men's building and Apt. #12 of the Women's building). Failure to register a visitor's car may result in it being towed at owner's expense.
2. It is in violation of the Student Center policy to register a friend's car as visiting so that they may park here while attending classes at MSU. If they are not physically here and there is reason to believe they are attending class or have business elsewhere, we will warn once and then tow at owners' expense.
