

Crocheted Ball

With size H hook and 4-ply yarn, chain 2. In 1st chain make single crochet (sc). Do not join rows together, work in spiral making sure to mark beginning of each row.

Row 2: 2 sc in each sc (12 stitches)

Row 3: 1 sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (18 stitches)

Row 4: 1 sc in first 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (24 stitches)

Row 5: 1 sc in first 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (30 stitches)

Row 6: 1 sc in first 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (36)

Row 7: 1 sc in first 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (42 stitches)

Row 8: 1 sc in first 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (48 stitches)

Row 9: 1 sc in first 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (54 stitches)

Row 10: 1 sc in first 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (60 stitches)

Row 11: 1 sc in first 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, repeat pattern to the end of the row (66 stitches)

Row 12-13: 1 sc in each sc to the end of the row (66 stitches)

Finish off. Cut yarn approx. 10" from last stitch. Pull through last stitch to end. Make two halves of ball. Sew the two pieces together with whip stitch. Leave enough room to put stuffing in middle. Finish whip stitching the ball.
