

## Batel Facilities

**\*\*LDS Standards should be followed at all times.**

### Fees:

Stake Fee for YW camp use: \$500 + \$12/YW attending camp

Contact Laramie Stake with the number of girls who attended. They will send a bill to your Stake at the end of the season. (Laramie is the managing stake for Batel)

Fee for non-YW camp use: \$3/person

Contact Laramie Stake Executive Secretary to reserve visits. Reservations can be made for times when not in use by YW Camps. (See the YW Camp Schedule page)

Fees pay for trash removal and latrine pumping as well as improvements to the property. The visitor per person fee might be waived if the group completes an approved service project. Coordinate this project with the Batel Manager and get approval in advance.

The YW camp fees also cover toiletries and use of the kitchen, archery equipment, and canoes. Some of the Batel equipment is only available for YW camp use. These items are indicated below.

### Camping:

Campsite 1: 5 tent pads Large Shelter

Campsite 2: 5 tent pads Large Shelter

Campsite 3: 5 tent pads Large Shelter

Campsite 4: 6 tent pads Small Shelter

Campsite 5: 6 tent pads Small Shelter

Campsite 6: 5 tent pads Large Shelter

Campsite 7: 7 tent pads Small Shelter

Campsite 8: 5 tent pads Small Shelter

Campsite 9: 8 tent pads Large Shelter

Priesthood: camp by lake ALL male visitors must sleep in the priesthood area

- Campsite shelters have concrete pad floors and eye bolts near the corners and in the center of the horizontal side beams. Small shelters have an eye bolt in the center of the shelter center beam.
- Large shelter- 20'3" sq. Small shelter- 16'4.5" sq. measured from outside edges of vertical support posts
- Each campsite has a fire pit and 2 picnic tables. During YW Camp season there is a 32 gal trash can with lid.
- There is no power at campsites. Power outlets are at the amphitheater and pavilion.
- There are a total of 52 tent pads sized to fit 10' x 14' tents.
