Pavilion

The covered pavilion includes 400 folding chairs, 35 round banquet tables, a sound system (indoor and out) with microphones and audio inputs for CD and computers, one large projection screen, a fireplace, beautiful views, a commercial-grade kitchen with two large refrigerators and one large freezer, restrooms, and an indoor meeting room.

NOTE: The kitchen is not equipped with cooking or serving items. It is the responsibility of the users to bring utensils, pots, etc., along with dish soap, dish cloths, aluminum foil, and other cooking supplies. The camp does provide brooms, mops, trash bags, squeegees, cleaning spray and window cleaner.

The main pavilion is often rented along with several campsites and used as a gathering place for large groups. No tents or "open-air" sleeping areas are allowed on the lawn around the pavilion.

CARE & CLEANING

- Clean and sanitize all cooking equipment, grills, stoves, sinks, refrigerators, freezer, stainless area behind stove, and food preparation and serving areas.

Please note - Special cleaning instructions for grill:

- 1) *Use a scraper on hot grill to remove food and grease.*
- 2) *Apply a coating of oil to grill. Hold the Grill-Brick with a cloth and clean with a back and forth motion, applying light pressure.*
- 3) *Scrape away all cleaning residue and wipe clean.*

- Remove and clean the slide-out grease collection trays for the grills and under the stove burners. Collect the grease, cool, and place in a trash bag. Please do not put grease in drains!
- Sweep and mop kitchen area.
- Clean and then neatly re-stack all chairs and tables in storage racks.
- Restrooms and showers need to be cleaned and sanitized, and floors mopped.
- Clean windows in all areas, including kitchen.
- Clean out fireplace. Please make sure ashes are cold before disposing of them. (When cold they may be placed in the dumpster behind pavilion.)

- Sweep concrete floor in large meeting area. Wash down with hose, if necessary, and then squeegee. (Please do not get water near the kitchen wall as the sheet rock and baseboards can be damaged.)
- Wash down outside concrete areas with provided hoses.
- Take all garbage to the dumpster and reline garbage cans with new bags.
- Return all equipment to the proper storage places.
- Check out with missionaries prior to departure.
