"I thirst" (John 19:28).

Jesus felt pain and was terribly thirsty. He understands whenever you feel sick or tired or hurt. Jesus wants us to help others who are ill or tired. What can you do to help someone in your family who isn't feeling well or is very tired?

"It is finished" (John 19:30).

Even though what Jesus was doing was really hard and hurt a lot, He didn't give up. He kept on doing the right thing because He loves us and He loves Heavenly Father. Sometimes we might feel like giving up, but we can choose to keep trying. What's something hard that you have done lately?

"Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do" (Luke 23:34).

Jesus forgave those who hurt Him. We should forgive other people too. Is there someone you can forgive?

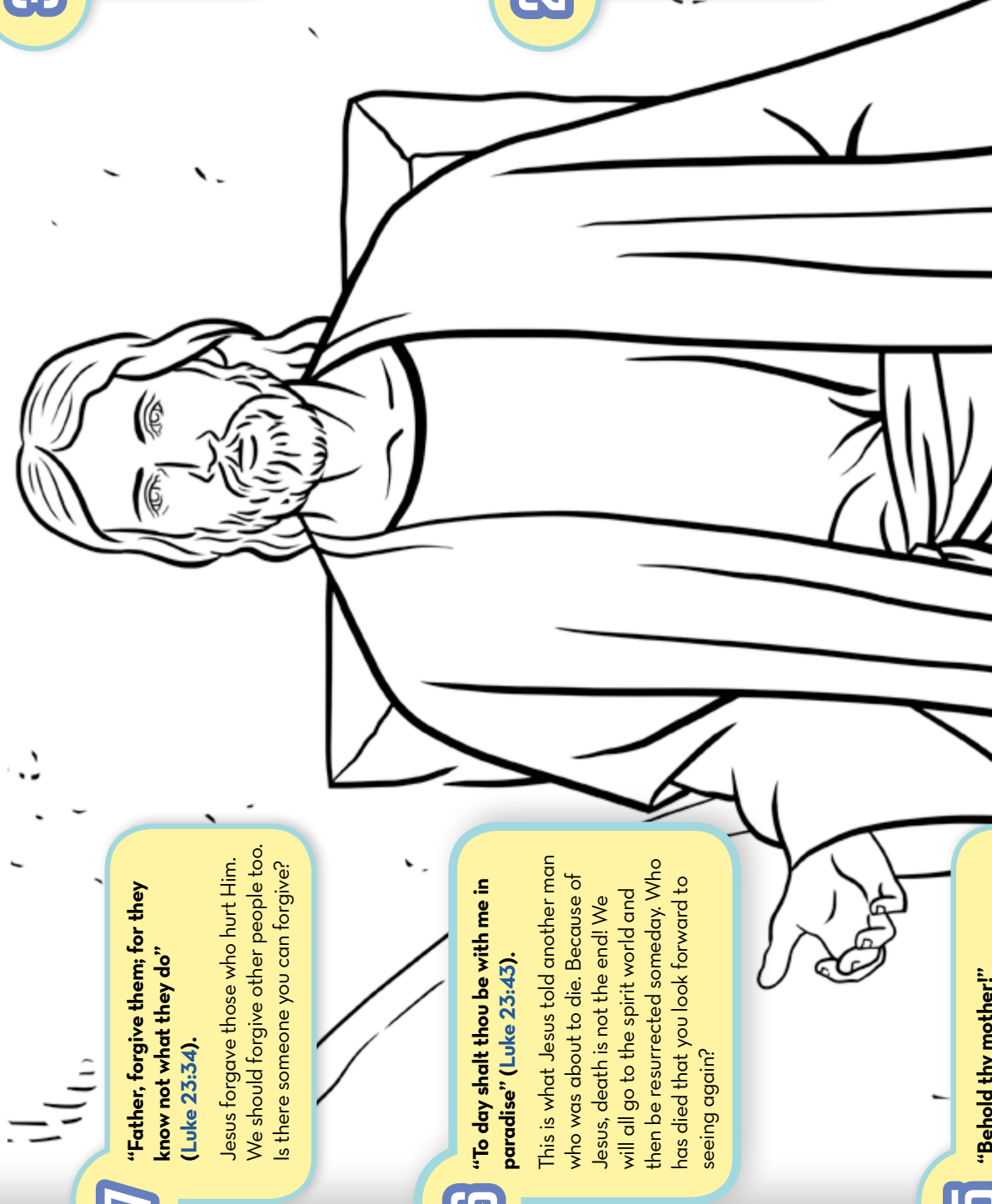

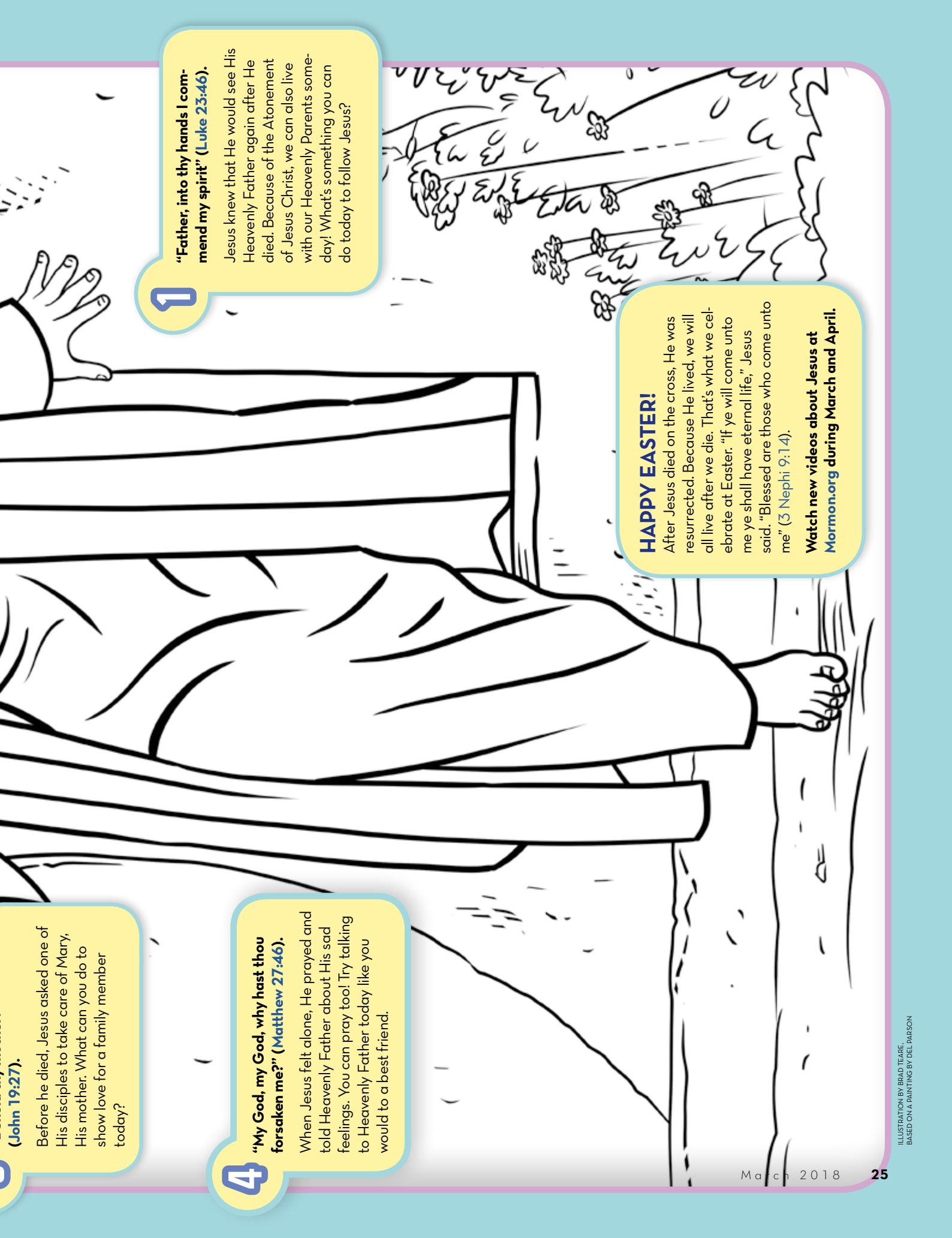
"To day shalt thou be with me in paradise" (Luke 23:43).
