

## FIND your family names



# TAKE your family names to the temple

1

Go to the Temple menu, and select **All Reserved**.

2

Select the **box** of the ancestor for whom you want to perform ordinances. Click the **Print** button.

3

Select  **Print Family Ordinance Cards** to print the ordinance card at home. Select  **Print an FOR** to print a Family Ordinance Request to bring to the temple and have the family ordinance cards printed there. Click **Continue**, and follow the instructions on the screen.

4

Take the name to the temple to perform ordinance work, or share it with a family member.

# TEACH your family members and others

Because family history and temple service focuses on families, it is often accomplished most joyfully by families. Follow the steps under Find and Take as a family whenever possible. Share your experiences with other family members and friends. Families who teach one another and serve together will be blessed to form eternal family bonds spanning the past, present, and future.
