

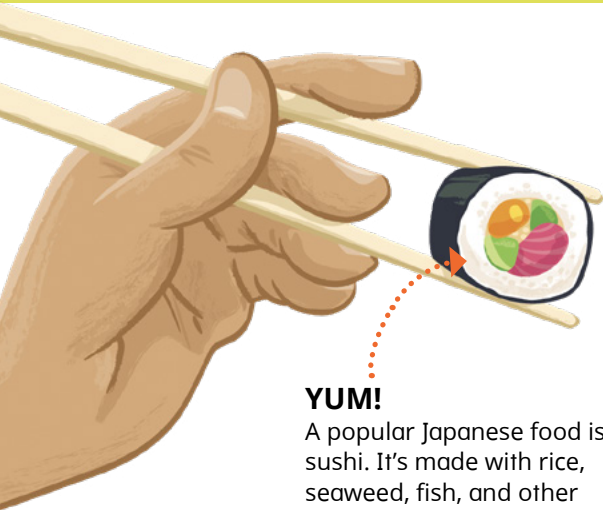


HELLO FROM Japan!
