Millions of people have been displaced from their homes the past few years, making this one of the greatest humanitarian crises the world has faced.



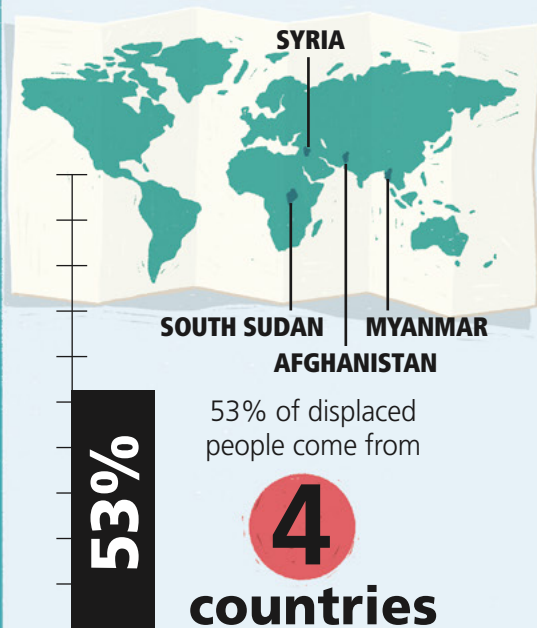
100 million

people have been forcibly displaced in the past decade



67% stay in their country of origin but lack basic needs

33% are refugees forced to flee their country—half under the age of 18

UGANDA



8 early childhood development centers built to serve nearly **3,000** refugee children and **210** certified teachers

YEMEN



1,100 students were provided learning materials

40 classrooms built

48,000 children were provided nutritious meals

1,800 out-of-school internally displaced children
